As we move into the fall of a year where our industry is in the process of contracting greatly, it appears that Texas bred breeders will continue to be an important resource, for dogs both at the tracks and at the NGA auction.

The TGA Board has approved Gulf Greyhound Park's application for race dates, which will provide for a meet with the same number of races as their last meet. The proposed meet will run from Jan. 2, 2020 to the end of February 2020. The Board has also approved the \$100,000 Texas Bred Futurity to be run during the GGP meet. We will continue to consider ways to expand our incentive program for Texas breeders and dog owners.

TGA Scholarship Essay

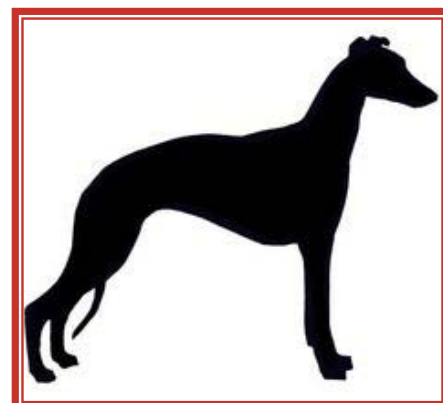

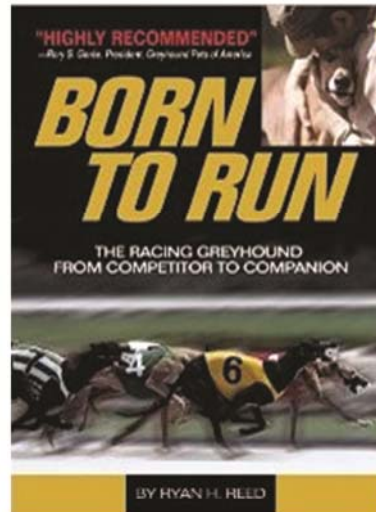
